TEMPORARY ORDERS IN RESPONSE TO THE COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)  
DATED MAY 4, 2021 VACATED

The Judge of the Court of Common Pleas of Miami County, Ohio, Juvenile/Probate Divisions makes the following Findings of Fact:


1. On May 12, 2021, Governor Mike DeWine announced Ohio Covid-19 health orders will terminate as of June 2, 2021.
2. On May 13, 2021, the CDC issued new CDC guidelines that fully vaccinated people can resume activities without wearing a mask or physically distancing.

Based upon these Findings of Fact, the Juvenile/Probate Divisions of the Court of Common Pleas will continue flexible responses in case the public health crisis escalates or increases in size or scope. The continuum of responses is intended to protect public health, to maintain essential court functions, and to continue to protect the rights of all individuals subject to the authority of the Court.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Effective June 2, 2021, the May 4, 2020, temporary order mandating use of masks is vacated.
2. Employees are encouraged to take regular breaks in order to thoroughly wash their hands.
3. Hand sanitizer shall be placed in high-contact locations.
4. Attorneys and litigants are encouraged to continue to file documents by FAX/Email. Marriage license applications will continue to be made through the Court's website portal; walk-ins are also welcome.
5. If there is a confirmed case of COVID-19, the individual will be isolated and medical care will be sought. The Court shall work with the local health department about suspected cases or exposure.
6. The Court continues to authorize the use of audio/visual devices and technologies for actions and proceedings.
7. The Court will have the lawful authority, within constitutional limits, to do and direct to be done all things necessary to ensure the orderly and efficient administration of justice for the duration of any declared public health emergency.
8. These Orders are subject to change based on Public Health Orders.
