

Now comes Plaintiff, Tyler Shoemaker and hereby Moves the Court for an Emergency Ex Parte Order of Temporary Custody. Plaintiff and Defendant have resided together with the minor child since before the birth of the minor child. However, in recent days Defendant has threatened and in fact has made arrangements to relocate with the minor child to Defendant's mother's home in Florida. Plaintiff has intercepted text messages between Defendant and her mother confirming the eminent relocation of Defendant and her intention to take the minor child with her. Defendant has no reliable transportation of her own (she intends to drive Plaintiff's car to Florida), no job and no means of supporting herself or her daughter. After intercepting the text messages between Defendant and her mother it has become clear to Plaintiff that Defendant and her mother are conspiring to facilitate the relocation without the knowledge of Plaintiff. Plaintiff's

Therefore, Plaintiff requests the Court issue and Ex Parte Order granting him interim temporary Custody until the Court establishes the parental rights and responsibilities of the parties pursuant to the Complaint which is filed contemporaneously with this Motion.






1. Plaintiff is the natural Father of the minor child Harmony E. Shoemaker DOB [REDACTED].
